3. The sufferings and death of Jesus

a) Matthew 26:57-68, 27:24-31, 38-44, 45-46 How do you respond to the sufferings and death of Christ as recorded by His disciple Matthew?

- b) What additional insights are given by Dr. Luke, after talking to eyewitnesses about the sufferings and death of Jesus? Luke 23:33-47
- c) What is the significance of the declaration of Jesus from the cross recorded by the apostle John? John 19:30
- d) What is your response as you contemplate the sufferings and death of Jesus for you?
- e) Why is the message of the cross foolishness to those who are perishing? 1 Corinthians 1:18-24

4. What the death of Jesus accomplished

- a) John 12:32-33 people would be drawn to Him
- b) John 3:16-17 people would have a choice to make
- c) Romans 10:13 everyone can choose to be saved
- d) John 1:11-13 those who choose to accept Jesus as their personal Savior are empowered to live as children of God.
- e) What other promises or stories in the New Testament assure us that our lives will be transformed when we experience a personal connection with Jesus as our Savior and Lord? Matthew Levi, Zacchaeus, Mary Magdalene, etc. 2 Corinthians 5:17, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, etc.
- f) Share your testimony of how your life has been transformed since you personally accepted all Jesus has accomplished for your salvation.
