PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The wise man Solomon reminds us, “To everything there is a season and a time for every purpose under heaven” (Ecclesiastes 3:1 NKJV). For our global church family and our worldwide Hope Channel evangelistic media network, now is a time to celebrate! This year, we are celebrating the 20th anniversary of Hope Channel’s global evangelistic media ministry, giving thanks and honor to God for all He has done.

Recognizing the need to expand our evangelistic media work worldwide, the Seventh-day Adventist church launched Hope Channel in 2003 with the specific mission to share God’s Good News for a better life today and for eternity. Hope Channel started as a small cluster of television channels under the visionary leadership of Elder Brad Thorp. Brad and his wife Kandus helped the network grow to over 40 channels in the next 13 years.

Having served as a volunteer host for Hope Sabbath School for eight years, I was invited to become President of Hope Channel International in 2016. Since then, Hope Channel’s network has expanded and diversified to include more than 80 channels broadcasting in over 100 languages on various media platforms.

Now is a time to celebrate the thousands of lives transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit. We know it’s all God’s work, but He uses people. He uses dedicated Hope Channel team members around the world, and He uses impact partners to come alongside and support this evangelistic media ministry with their prayers and financial gifts.

Recently, Rado Rakotonandrasana, our Director for Hope Channel Indian Ocean, contacted me with an urgent request. He was facing a logistical challenge. Launched just a few years ago, this new channel now broadcasts two hours per week on national television. The viewers’ response was so overwhelming that his phone battery was depleted in the first few hours each day. He was also running out of minutes before the end of the month! Viewers were calling in search of hope!

A generous donor couple in the US had helped to provide funds to launch Hope Channel Indian Ocean. They had a special burden for the French-speaking territories around the world. The husband now sleeps in Jesus, but I contacted his widow to share all the LORD is doing through this evangelistic media ministry based in Madagascar. She was so excited—she offered to purchase a new iPhone for the ministry and unlimited minutes for the

next three years! I have no doubt there was a time of celebration among the team members at Hope Channel Indian Ocean.

A few weeks ago, Pastor Mark Finley conducted the *Hope For Africa* evangelistic meetings in Nairobi, Kenya. A 24/7 broadcasting schedule begins in North America, allowing viewers access to uplifting and inspiring content around the clock.

Hope Channel's new facilities open for use, **allowing for high-definition (HD) and fully digital production.**

In February, **Hope Channel transitions to a commercial live-streaming and video-on-demand platform** to meet the evolving preferences of viewers for accessible and flexible content.

Hope Channel introduces its first Roku app in November, demonstrating dedication to reaching diverse audiences through emerging technologies. Hope Channel is one of the early religious organizations on this platform.

Hope Channel goes live in North America on January 9.

Prime-time shows include: *Let's Pray*, *StoryLine*, *Cross Connection*, *Beginnings*, and *Disclosure: The Future Declassified*. These programs enrich viewers' evenings with dynamic content, fostering spiritual engagement and reflection.

Go Healthy for Good launches on September 10.

Hosted by Dr. Nerida McKibben, this live program empowers viewers with insights for well-being.

HC Australia, TV Producciones Costarricenses, S.A., HC Italy, HC Poland, HC Ukraine join the global network.

Hope Channel becomes a separate financial entity with its own books of accounts.

In addition Hope Channel upgraded its website. This upgrade underlined the commitment to communicating uplifting content in a user-friendly manner.

Hope Channel wins three prestigious Telly Awards,

triumphing over more than 12,000 entries from around the globe. The Telly Awards recognize the channel's impact in using media to share inspiration with diverse audiences, solidifying Hope Channel's position as a leading force in the Christian media industry.

HC Indonesia, HC Kenya, HC Philippines, Nuevo Tiempo Espana, and Esperanza TV Venezuela join the global network.

Hope Channel moves to DIRECTV HD.

This transition to high-definition broadcasting offers viewers crystal-clear visuals and immersive audio quality.

Broadcast operations move to the Silver Spring, Maryland headquarters

after a decade of broadcasting from Simi Valley, California, exemplifying commitment to advanced technology and streamlined content delivery.

HC Portugal, Telekanal "Nadezhda" (HC Russia), HC Fiji, HC France, and HC American Samoa join the global network.



Hope Channel launches a suite of brand-new apps for the global network, for the first time bringing a consistent design across all platforms, including iOS, Android, Roku, Apple TV, and Amazon Fire TV.

Hope Channel launches its first Study Tour. Led by esteemed scholars, these tours offer participants a chance to explore biblical history, connect with their faith heritage, and renew their spiritual commitment.

HC Afrikaans, HC Central Asia, HC Finland, HC Ghana, Reménység Média (HC Hungary), HC Iceland, and HC Singapore join the global network.



The corporate name changes to Hope Channel International, Inc. This marks a significant step towards embracing a global identity and reaffirms Hope Channel's commitment to reach diverse cultures with the gospel.

Hope Channel broadcasts the 2019 International Pathfinder Camporee.

HC Ethiopia, HC Israel, and HC Zimbabwe join the global network.

Hope Channel creates a digital distribution team in February to oversee the online distribution of digital media content.

Hope Channel's first 100% digitally distributed program launches on April 6. "Small Talk, Big God" began as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic but grew into a global community of discussion, encouragement, and hope. In its short run of just a few months, it receives millions of views from around the world.

Day of Hope premieres on December 15, becoming Hope Channel's first-ever telethon broadcast. The program shares what God is doing worldwide through Hope Channel and invites viewers to financially support this powerful impact movement.



Building a God-Sized Vision

Hope Channel began with the dream of creating a Seventh-day Adventist television channel that would broadcast 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It was a vision that stretched the imagination and sent us to our knees, yet it was only the beginning of what God had in mind. Today, Hope Channel International is at the forefront of taking the hope of the Three Angels Messages around the world with its current network of 81 channels broadcasting in over 100 languages.

The story of how Hope Channel became the world's largest denominationally-owned religious television network is a story of dreaming big with God. It is

a story of miracles and bold faith, of hard work and long prayers. It is a story of hope.

“It is amazing how Hope Channel has proliferated all over the globe,” says Ted Wilson, President of the General Conference of Seventh-Day Adventists. “We have stations broadcasting to different cultures and in multiple languages. People have gravitated to supporting front-line mission evangelism.”

Hope Channel International is ever-evolving proof that when we let God grow our vision, He doesn't just

multiply our efforts—He'll send them around the world to the places they are needed most.

The Journey to 24/7 Evangelism

The opportunities to use technology to reach people personally have exploded in the last 30 years. It wasn't YouTube "shorts" or Facebook "reels" that had the church abuzz in the 1990s. Satellite technology was the latest method for sharing the gospel then.

Pastor Mark Finley preached the first satellite NET evangelistic series in 1995. Broadcast to 676 North American churches, it reached 66,000 people. Over 7,000 were baptized as a result.

"It was an amazing tool to share the message of the gospel with millions!" remembers Pastor Brad Thorp. Pastor Thorp helped coordinate the NET

meetings and later served as the first president of Hope Channel from 2003 to 2016. "A dream was born in my heart of what a blessing this could be to the entire world."

In 1998, the *NeXt Millennium* seminar with Pastor Dwight Nelson became the largest evangelistic event ever held by a Christian church. "We did the series in 40 languages and had multiple broadcasts to accommodate the time changes," says Kandus Thorp, who served as Hope Channel's vice president for international development until 2016. "It was such an exciting moment for the Adventist church because we were all involved in something bigger than ourselves."

Satellite evangelism gave the Adventist church a glimpse of what could be accomplished through large-scale media ministry. "We realized we needed a 24/7 television ministry produced by the church to reach the homes of people around the world," says Jan Paulsen,

former General Conference President.

Challenges Along the Way

“Most people did not understand the impact of full-time evangelistic programming, 24 hours, seven days a week, 365 days a year. I think it's still a challenge today in 2023,” says Pastor Thorp.

“We were impressed that the biggest challenge would be thinking too small,” adds Kandus Thorp.

As with any effort to accomplish something Satan despises, these challenges have required much prayer and thought. How could we produce enough programming for one 24/7 channel, let alone multiple channels for multiple cultures in multiple languages? For many, it seemed an insurmountable problem.

Other challenges also presented themselves. “When you start a new program such as this, the first big challenge is how to fund it,” remembers Paulsen. “We needed equipment and airtime and everything else to get set up. Then there was the question of qualified personnel because we realized from the outset that we couldn't do everything from the headquarters at the General Conference.”

The Scope of God's Ministry Revealed

The past twenty years have been full of miracles. Over and over again, in every corner of the globe, dedicated church members have caught the vision of 24/7 evangelism. New media centers and broadcast centers have been established. Thousands of hours of

Biblical programming have been recorded and broadcast, profoundly impacting the growth of God's truth worldwide.

The development of the Internet and online platforms like Facebook and YouTube have allowed the sharing of the gospel in regions where Adventist populations are small or non-existent. Channels like Hope MENA in the Middle East are reaching thousands through their YouTube channels who may never otherwise hear of Jesus. In Germany, the Adventist church is small, but 18% of the country's population is watching Hope Channel.

“I believe this is a fulfillment of Bible prophecy that says that the gospel is to be taken to the entire world,” reflects Kandus Thorp. “Hope Channel is a big part of the great work that God's people are doing around the world. The Three Angels flying in the midst of Heaven is very real when you think of how we broadcast in more than 100 different languages to cultures all around the globe.”

Making a Worldwide Impact

Hope Channel International is grateful for the exponential growth God has made possible. Its full-time networks now cover North America, Inter-America, South America, Africa, Europe, Asia, and Oceania. Twenty-one new full-time global networks have been launched in the last two years alone. Around 302,000 students are enrolled in the Hope.Study online Bible school, with access to over 20 courses. Hope Channel is moving into cinematic productions with the establishment of Hope Studios. There are now 83 growing YouTube channels. The *Bible Heroes* game app has been downloaded more than 900,000 times.

“We have a massive challenge still ahead

of us,” says President Morris. “I envision the Seventh-Day Adventist Church taking advantage of whatever new way comes available for communicating the gospel. Our goal is that Hope Channel will be a resource for everyone, bringing conversions everywhere, and sharing the gospel to the ends of the Earth.”

God’s vision for Hope Channel still stretches our imagination and sends us to our knees. Won’t you join us in prayer as we seek to reach billions of His children with the hope of eternity? We’ve only just begun to see what great things God can do.

Net Series Yield Exponential Growth in Africa

Anna Charles ran a small bar for many years to support herself and her family. Then one day in 2021, she heard about the *Joy in His Way* series that Hope Channel planned to broadcast to 3000 downlink sites in her home country of Tanzania. Anna offered her bar as a satellite downlink center, hoping it would bring her more customers.

Anna surprised everyone by accepting Jesus as her Lord and Savior during the second week of the series. She gave away all her alcohol and was baptized along with 11 of her friends and customers. Over 30,000 precious souls were baptized in Tanzania during the *Joy in His Way* series. Another 18,240 Tanzanians were baptized one year later in the *Footsteps of Hope* series.

We believe this is only the beginning of what God wants to do in Africa. That's why Hope Channel International is conducting two Net evangelistic series in Africa this fall.

Pastor Mark Finley led the *Hope for Africa* evangelistic outreach from September 2 to 16. It was downloaded to more than 10,000 sites throughout the East-Central Africa Division. In advance of this major event, 15,000 precious souls were baptized in the Eastern Ethiopia Union Mission.

Pastor Chris Holland, senior evangelist of Hope Channel, will preach the *Almost Home* series from October 20 to November 3 in Port Harcourt, Nigeria. The West-Central Africa Division plans to have over 2,000 downlink sites for this series. "We are thrilled with what God is doing!" says Elder Robert Osei-Bonsu, president of the West-Central Africa Division. A major baptism is planned for November 4 as part of Nigeria's centenary celebration of the establishment of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church there.

Hope Channel India Reaches Thousands

India has just one Seventh-day Adventist for every 13,000 people, yet God's work is moving forward rapidly in this populous nation.

Evil spirits had possessed Durga for many years. She was curious when she heard about meetings Hope Channel India was hosting near her village in Chhattisgarh, India. She attended and something inside her stirred as she heard a powerful sermon on God's remnant church, and she came forward for the appeal despite the demons jerking her body from side to side.

The Adventists in Durga's area had been fasting and praying in preparation for the June 2023 meetings, and nearly 1,000 people attended. The Holy Spirit moved mightily. Durga and four others were freed from demonic control, and hundreds accepted Christ. Today, Durga joyfully participates in the growing Adventist congregation in her village.

Similar stories are unfolding all across India as dedicated Adventists partner with Hope Channel's media ministries. Begun in 2009 with a single production studio, Hope Channel India now has multiple production studios and broadcasts in six languages. Over 2000 shows were produced in 2022 and broadcast via television, satellite, and internet to a potential audience of 750 million people.

The Adventist church in India is celebrating Hope Channel's 20th anniversary by conducting 20 evangelism meetings, planting 20 churches, and creating 20 new YouTube channels in 2023. They are also praying for 2,000 baptisms. Thousands have already accepted Christ due to revival meetings that drew up to 25,000 per night.



A Healed Life in the Solomon Islands

Garry Eliphas was an alcoholic with a desire to know the truth. He eagerly read the truth-filled literature that his coworkers at the timber milling company shared with him. He was especially interested in the Sabbath and health.


In 2018, he came across Hope FM 88.1, Hope Channel's radio station in the Solomon Islands. "I heard Dr. Chester Kuma speak on how to live a healthy lifestyle and how those health principles apply to the spiritual aspect of our body," says Garry. "I have never missed listening to Hope FM until today." He also began to listen to the Hope Channel Solomon Islands television station.

Garry soon quit smoking and drinking.

His health rapidly improved, and it wasn't long before people in his community took notice. Whenever anyone asked about his transformation, he told them about Hope Channel and Hope FM and showed them how to listen on their cell phones.

In 2020, Garry began Bible studies with Pastor Silent Tovosia, then president of the Solomon Islands Mission. He was baptized in November 2020 during a Hope Channel evangelism campaign. Since then, Garry has been actively serving the Lord in his local Adventist church. He shares his testimony of transformation and hope with everyone he can, encouraging them to embrace a healthier lifestyle and explore a relationship with God.





“What Am I Doing Here, Jesus?”

It's a question that “Let's Pray” host Season Cromwell frequently asks herself. “Being able to work with Hope Channel isn't just a job. It is everything to me,” she says. “I'll follow Jesus wherever he takes me, but being a part of this ministry is the greatest honor of my working life.”

Sexually abused on multiple occasions as a child, Season grew up feeling like she had a target on her back. “I made terrible choices,” she recalls. Alcohol and meth gave her momentary relief from the anxiety, but “I became a danger to myself and others.”

Then came the moment when “I knew that if I didn't choose life, I was choosing death by default.” She chose life, and Jesus began the work of healing. “I had no idea how to be normal or have healthy relationships. Jesus provided so

many things to sustain me when I was so fragile.” One of those supports was a godly couple who prayed with her and helped her replace her broken beliefs with the truths of God's Word.

Working with Hope Channel since 2012 has allowed God to continue His work in Season's life. “The Father has been able to reach deep inside me and rework my behaviors and mindsets. He's given me excellent examples of leadership, integrity, honor, the Word of God, mission, and stewardship here. The people at Hope Channel are so dear and so authentic.”

“And now I host a prayer program!” Her amazement is obvious. “What am I doing here, Jesus?! He tells me, ‘You're glorifying my name by telling people what I've done for you.’”
