1. Justified by faith in Jesus

- a) Romans 5:1-5
- b) What are your thoughts about the fact that our justification has already been accomplished through Jesus Christ (having been justified)? What is left for us to do?
- c) When did God set this plan into motion? Romans 5:6–8 (see also 1 Peter 1:18–21)

2. Saved from wrath through Jesus

- a) Romans 5:9 (see also 1 Thessalonians 1:10)
- b) Some people view God the Father as an angry deity and Jesus the Son as a loving and kind Savior. What is the truth about the character of our heavenly Father?
- c) What texts in the Scriptures help us to understand the wrath of God? Romans 1:18 (contrast with John 3:16–17 and 2 Peter 3:9)

3. Reconciled by His death and saved by His life

- a) Romans 5:10-11
- b) In addition to being rescued from penalty and power of sin, what other reason do we have to rejoice?
- c) What does Paul mean when he says we are "saved by His life"? (see 1 Corinthians 15:19–22)
- 4. Sin brings death
 - a) Romans 5:12

- b) What word is repeated over and over again as Paul describes what Jesus has accomplished for us?
- c) What other passages of Scripture remind us salvation is a gift?

- d) When did you accept the gift of life through Jesus?
