# WRAPPED IN LOVE

“When my aunt Bea was alive, it was playing on her TV all the time, 24/7,” says Akivah Northern about how she learned of Hope Channel. “She was especially a fan of the show *Go Healthy for Good*.”

So, when Aunt Bea was approaching her 106th birthday, Akivah had an idea. She contacted Hope Channel to see if *Go Healthy for Good* would like to feature her aunt’s long and healthy life. Show host Dr. Nerida loved the idea, and travelled to Santa Barbara with a crew to interview Aunt Bea (Meet Aunt Bea at 49:55 minutes into this episode: [hopetv.org/longevity](http://hopetv.org/longevity))

After Aunt Bea passed away, Akivah continued watching Hope Channel. She enjoyed it so much that she began to find ways to incorporate Hope Channel shows into the many community and health projects within her non-profit organization, Media Medicine Group. When she found a bargain deal on a giant digital billboard space towering high in New York City’s Times Square, she immediately thought of Hope Channel. “I knew that people would see through the glitter and glitz of the retail advertisements all around and notice Hope Channel,” says Akivah. “I knew Hope Channel would just pop with its simple logo, bright colors, and its tagline *Television that changes lives*. People want to change—they want a better, happier life.”

This advertising opportunity was more than just a great bargain. It was a providential gift that allowed Hope Channel to tell the thousands who walked by that God’s good news was on free-to-air television in New York. Even though Hope Channel has been broadcasting in the New York area for two years, many people often discover it only accidentally while

flipping through channels. This giant advertisement was going to make a big difference! “Through this opportunity God was providing just what Hope Channel needed at just the right time,” says Akivah.

Hope Channel quickly went to work on the advertisement, a “bow-tie” display (one that expands the visual boundary at right angles so people from intersecting streets can view it). The 16,414-square-foot space, right above a prominent Revlon advertisement on the corner of 1500 Broadway and 43rd Street, displayed an invitation to watch Hope Channel on WMBQ 46.2—the television station that changes lives.

“Not only were we able to run our digital ad several times an hour, every hour for seven straight days, our ad was 20 seconds in length instead of the typical 10 seconds,” shares a Hope Channel representative. “It was a miracle for us to get the space—and to get it for the price we did. What an excellent opportunity to reach a large segment of potential viewers.”

Akivah is like many of Hope Channel’s viewers who do more than watch the shows. They are ambassadors for this broadcast ministry. They use Hope Channel as a tool to strengthen and share their faith.

“I’m glad I could help,” says Akivah. “Times Square is a huge and very public place where people enjoy coming to visit from all around the world. Yet almost every single billboard in this famous square is selling something. This space with Hope Channel’s message simply spoke of God’s love that is available to every one.” 🙌

## ADVERTISING COST

It costs between \$1.1 and \$4 million a year to buy advertising space in Times Square. That roughly translates to \$3,000 per day for the least expensive advertising.

But through the opportunity shared by Akivah, Hope Channel paid a very tiny fraction of the average cost. Not only was the price an incredible bargain, it was also on par with what Hope Channel currently pays for some of its print ad space!

# Never Too Late, Never Too Old

It's 10 o'clock in the morning. Stacks of mail just got dumped on the counter of Hope Channel's Viewer Services office. Held together by thick rubber bands, it's an assortment of donations, letters, bank statements, and the usual quota of junk mail. Recently, Carmen has developed a habit of thumbing through each stack, looking for a square envelope with a Philadelphia postmark.

A smile spreads across Carmen's face as the familiar scrawl on a tidy white envelope emerges from the pile. Happiness and feelings of kinship with an unknown elderly woman from Philly bubble to the surface as she rushes across the hall to show the letter—and two worn \$5 bills tucked inside—to a coworker.

"I've never met her," says Carmen. "I don't even know her name. But I'd recognize her handwriting anywhere. Every few weeks since October 2014 Hope Channel has received a note and some cash from our friend in Philly."

The envelopes do not include a return address. Cash, from \$10 to \$30, is wrapped inside unsigned notes of thanks and encouragement. The notes contain just enough information to piece together a picture.

Through the months Hope Channel employees have, in their imagination, made this special, anonymous donor a part of their life at Hope Channel. They call her Mabel. "I imagine Mabel living in a small, two-

bedroom apartment in a brick building with a deli or a convenience store on the ground floor," says one employee. "Maybe that's where she buys the stamps for her envelopes."

Another employee adds, "I'd like to think she has a desk that faces a small window framed with thin, fluttery curtains she sewed decades ago when her fingers were young and nimble. Her view is not much to look at—across the alley is just another red brick building. But she's not at her desk for the view. She sits to write her love notes. Her frugality kicks in, and she tears a sheet of paper horizontally into three strips for three short letters. She prays as she writes to those who have made a difference in her life, to those for whom she has concern, to those who are going through difficult times. Then she takes an envelope from a small stack—some are blue, some yellow, some white, but all faded and musty with time."

"We know that Mabel watches Hope Channel on DirecTV," says Carmen, emphasizing that this is a fact and not part of her imaginings. "I think it's cute that she addresses every envelope to 'Channel 368' because that's where she gets Hope Channel on her television."

The small cash donation she sends seems to indicate that she is on a fixed income. "I wonder if Mabel saves something out of her grocery budget?" a volunteer at Hope Channel asks of the group hovering over the lat-

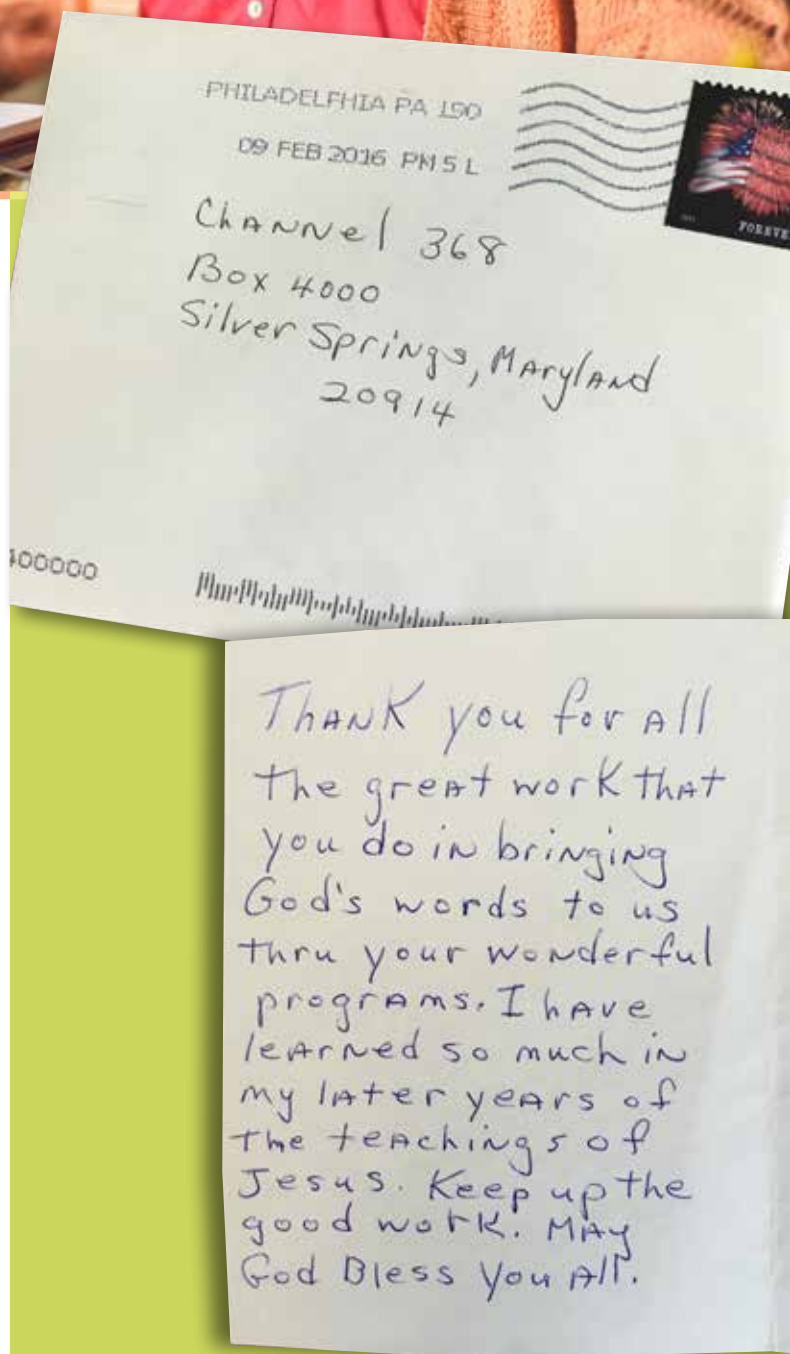


est square envelope. “Maybe she is like the widow in Jesus’s story—the one who dropped her two mites into the offering (see Mark 12:41–44).”

Regardless of her financial status, Mabel, the anonymous donor, gives out of love and appreciation—and she gives generously from the joy of having found Jesus. In one of her penned notes, she writes, “I watch many of the programs . . . I have learned so much in my elder years.”

“This woman’s letters and donations have let me see how Hope Channel helps lead people to Jesus and His Word—no matter their age,” says Carmen. “And I’m reminded of this Bible text in Psalm 92:13–15: ‘The righteous will flourish in the courts of our God. They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green, proclaiming, “The Lord is upright; he is my Rock, and there is no wickedness in him”’ (NIV).”

Maybe Mabel has a family with whom she’s excitedly sharing her faith. Or maybe she’s alone and Hope Channel has not only brought Jesus into her life, but also keeps her company. Regardless, the verses in Psalm 92 concur with what Mabel writes, “As the saying goes, you are never too old to learn. May God bless you all.” 🙏

My job as manager of Web services for Hope Channel's global headquarters is diverse and challenging . . . and I love it!

Over the past few years, the distinction between television and the Internet has become blurry. Before, television was something viewed on a relatively large screen and received with antenna, satellite dish, or cable subscription. Now, television encompasses delivery of video content via the Internet as well. And with the rise of mobile devices, the small screen in your pocket is another way to reach others with the gospel.

With this revolution in connectivity, television viewers' expectations are becoming more sophisticated. Most viewers now expect a seamless viewing experience across broadcast, mobile apps, IPTV set top boxes, and the Web. Achieving this seamless experience requires television networks such as Hope Channel to invest in powerful data management systems that operate behind the scenes.

My primary responsibility is to create these systems, putting Hope Channel on the leading

edge of modern television delivery so that we can minister to viewers around the world, no matter how they're connected. When complete, Hope Channel will have a brand new website, apps for every device, and a completely connected viewing experience.
