# Stitches of Faith

The yarn felt rougher than usual as she formed the beginning chain of a new crocheted hat. Her infant son Josiah was resting nearby. Jill stayed close to him because she was worried—worried for her son’s health and his future. Days after Josiah was born he was diagnosed with viral meningitis, which caused severe seizures called infantile spasms. If his condition continued, doctors told her, it could result in permanent brain damage that would affect him for the rest of his life.

Jill glanced over again at her baby boy now peacefully sleeping, connected to monitors and a tangle of wires and tubes. Needing something to distract her from the beeping and alarming sounds in their NICU room, she was glad she had brought her crochet. Her hands worked deftly. She didn’t have to watch her fingers. Never having used patterns, her creative mind invented intricate designs while her fingers skillfully turned and twisted the hook—making stitches and colors do exactly what they should. Jill wished that she had that sort of certainty for Josiah’s life.

The crochet wasn’t calming her as she had hoped. Noticing the time, Jill realized that one of her favorite Hope Channel programs, *Let’s Pray*, was currently airing. Jill had begun watching the show years ago

Each night, as I close my eyes, I whisper to myself, “Another day I have survived.”

The loss of someone is palpable in your everyday experience. Everywhere I look, I see my husband. From grocery stores, to roads travelled, to food shared. I glance at my phone, waiting for a text from him that will never come.

We were apart when he passed away, but he always sent me texts, asking me how I was doing and how Jojo was doing. It was really hard being apart from him, but somehow just a text was enough.

I found a note he left me two months earlier . . . He was tired of running, tired of fighting mental illness. He wanted peace. It wasn’t the right way, but for him, it was the answer. He left behind children that needed him. But for Seth, he couldn’t grasp that concept because he just was too broken.

This world is a hard place, trust me. In a year I have been through Josiah battling meningitis, then epilepsy, and now my husband. Yeah, this world is a hard place. But I will not stop singing God’s praises, that even amidst this nightmare, God still has provided. I have become close to Seth’s family and that in itself is a beautiful thing for me. Seth will live on through his children, and I will make sure to do all that Seth wanted to do to help others. I know, through this, God will have something good come out of it. He always does. For God is in the business of saving, not for this world but for eternity.

at the suggestion of her mother, and over the years she had often watched *Let's Pray* while crocheting. But tonight Jill had nearly forgotten and, besides, there was no television in the hospital room.

Being a regular *Let's Pray* viewer though, Jill knew the hosts and remembered that the prayer team took prayer requests by phone, email, and social media. So even though she wasn't watching the show that night, she got on the *Let's Pray* Facebook page, and submitted her prayer request. It wasn't long before Jill received many responses and reminders that miles away, in the Hope Channel studios, there were people praying for her. Other viewers on Facebook also joined in support of Jill through even more prayers.

Over the next few days, Jill's hands continued working quickly, but more calmly. Peace was returning to her heart knowing that others were praying for her and that God was in control over her life and little Josiah's.

Realizing that others might also need the same kind of comfort and hope that she was receiving from the Word of God through Hope Channel, Jill decided to turn her crochet business into a witnessing tool. Jill had started her crocheting home business four years before Josiah was born. It helped cover expenses and allowed her to be a stay-at-home mom for her daughter Maddie. The business was well established, and Jill was thankful that God had led her to start a business that allowed her to continue staying home to care of her sick baby. Now she was going to use her products to lead others to Hope Channel and to Christ.

With each order she mails, Jill includes a Hope Channel "leave behind" card. Jill believes her crocheted projects could be just the reminder someone needs of a loving God who hears and responds. One stitch at a time, Jill serves as a witness for Christ. 🙏

# He Gives Me Strength

Floyd had experienced many difficult times in his life, but this was the worst yet. He had lost his job as a police officer in Texas when he refused to take an assignment with which he felt uncomfortable. This resulted in him relocating his family to Louisiana, from where, for more than seven years, Floyd commuted to work with the police force in Little Rock, Arkansas. Then one day it happened—he sustained a major back injury and was denied workers' compensation. After months on his back and mounting medical bills, the family was in financial ruin. His wife, no longer able to handle the hardship, took their children and left, cutting all ties of support and communication.

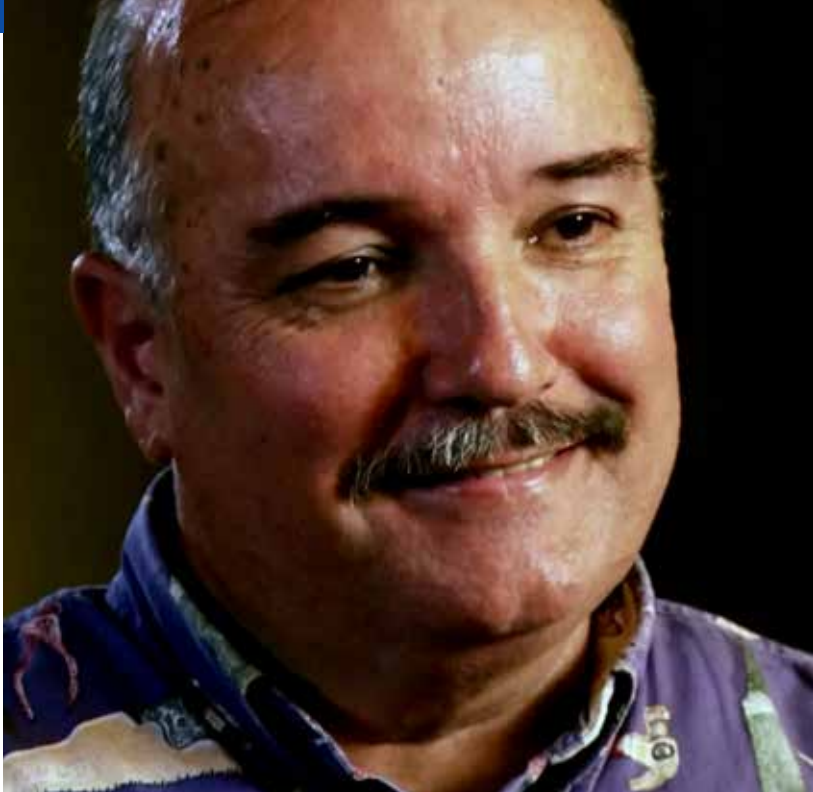
Floyd lay on his bed, tears streaming down his face. What was he to do now? There was no joy or hope left in life. He wished for death.

And death almost came in August 2009, when Floyd suffered from two heart attacks in the same day. He believed that the next face he would see was that of Jesus, yet the Lord sustained him. Floyd realized he was being given a second chance. He had attended church as a child but had never developed a personal relationship with Christ, although the Savior had a special place in his heart. The near death experience made Floyd realize just how great his need of God was, and that night he cried before the Lord, "Father, I'm ready to know you more. Please, lead me to a church where they are teaching the truth of the Bible."

Floyd continued to pray this prayer every day. On the fourth day, while flipping through TV channels, he stumbled upon Hope Channel. Something about the programs struck a chord in Floyd's heart. He continued to watch Hope Channel every day, soaking in everything he was learning about God and Scripture. Then Floyd called Hope Channel viewer services, looking for a church family to join. He was connected to a church near his home where he was baptized in December 2010.

Since his baptism, Floyd has been an active worker for the Lord, sharing his testimony with anyone who listens. Throughout the years he has touched many lives in his church and community. Floyd's sole desire has been to glorify God with his life.

In April of this year, Floyd was diagnosed with Lou Gehrig's disease, more commonly known as ALS. This disease, which damages the motor neurons in the brain and spinal cord, is

often fast acting and leaves individuals weak and unable to care for themselves.

Despite this poor diagnosis, Floyd has not relented in his ministry work and continues to witness to people at any opportunity. When his doctor informed him of his prognosis, she began to cry. Floyd comforted her by claiming the promise of eternal life and the soon coming of Jesus. His assurance in salvation touched not only his doctor, but the nurses and other patients as well.

Many people have been visiting Floyd, wanting to spend time with him before he passes away. He uses these visits as opportunities to share Jesus. He usually starts with "You need to see the color on this thing," gesturing towards his large screen TV and inviting his visitors to watch a Hope Channel show with him. This often leads to long conversations!

Though his condition worsens with each day, Floyd is grateful for the work Christ has done in his life. His life is filled with joy and hope because Jesus is in it. He no longer desires death as he did only a few short years ago; neither is he afraid. He knows his eternity is secure in his Savior.

Floyd may have gone through the worst of times, yet he can claim the words of Paul: "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. I can do all this through Him who gives me strength" (Phil 4:11–13). 🙏

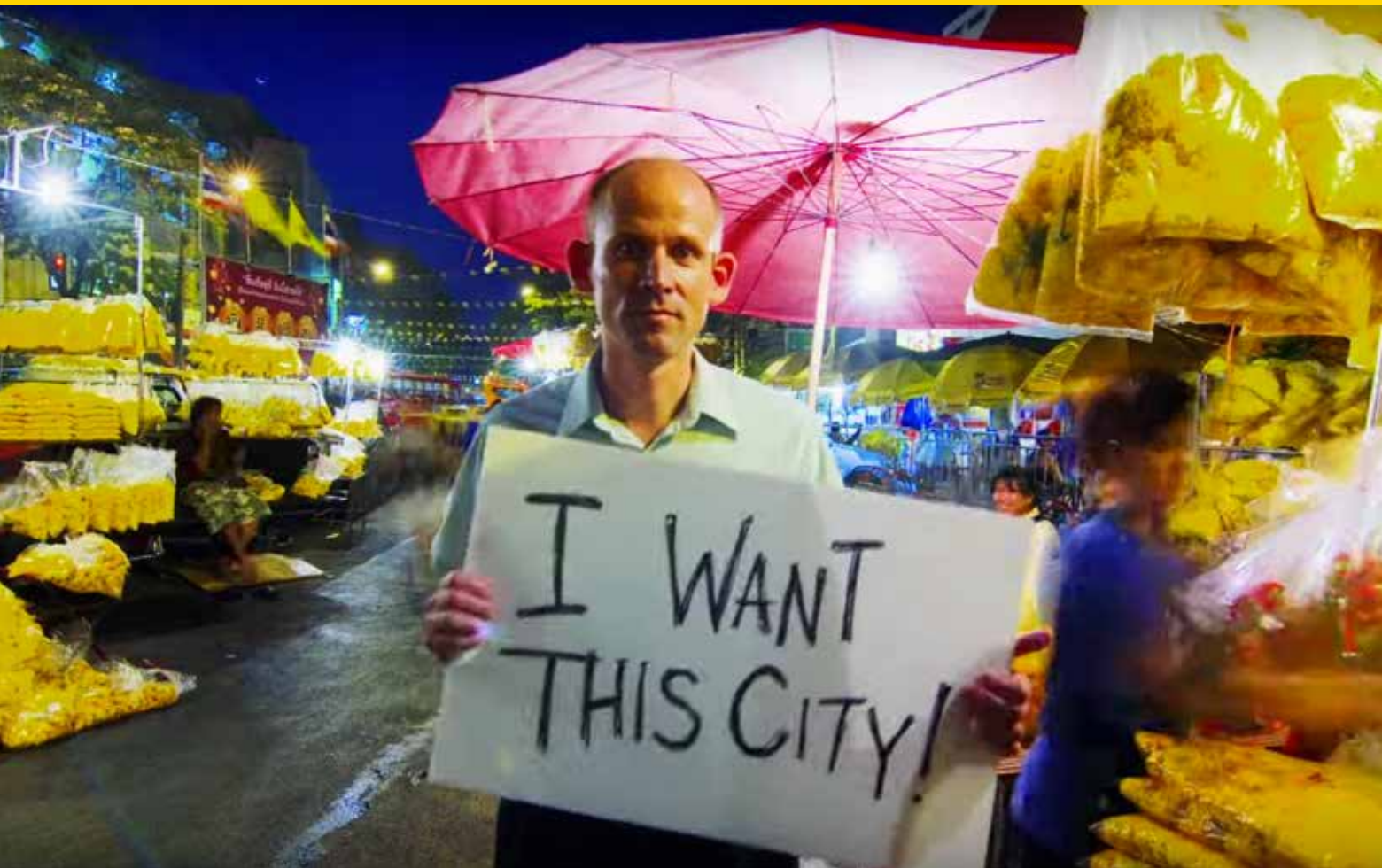

### A docuseries about one man's desire to share Jesus with the city of Bangkok

Walking around New York City it would be difficult to find someone who has not heard of Jesus. But do the same on the streets of Bangkok and the majority would have no clue.

Missionary Doug Venn spent five years finding ways to share Jesus in Thailand's capital. He found unlimited opportunities; but the limitations were often heartbreaking. One of his most trying experiences was when leaders of a slum area offered land to build a church. Doug was excited until he realized that the \$30,000 needed for the construction just could not be raised.

He was challenged again when looking for Bible studies to share. He discovered that the only lessons available at the church office in Bangkok were photocopies of photocopies of even older photocopies—the fuzzy, blotchy print made them difficult to read. He says, "The literature rack at my local church in the United States was better stocked than the one we have here. There we were just trying to serve one or two cities of 50,000; here we are trying to reach a nation of 65 million."

Watch *I Want This City* and travel with Doug by water taxi, motorcycle taxi, tuk tuk, and sky train. Experience the huge need for Jesus in the city of Bangkok where less than three percent is Christian. 🙏

This past March Claude was able to return home to the Dominican Republic where both his wife and he preached a two-week series in Villa-Sonador and Bonao. Hosts of various shows often share with the crew messages they receive from viewers, and we are greatly blessed to hear these stories. I praise God that although what I do behind the scenes may never be seen by the viewers, I

am part of a team that creates programs that encourage people to study the Word of God. What I do results in many entering into a relationship with Him. This excites me!

I love people. I love interacting with people and making them laugh. Most importantly, I love sharing Jesus with people because I know that He loves each person more than anyone can imagine. In my professional and personal life, I strive to represent Christ.

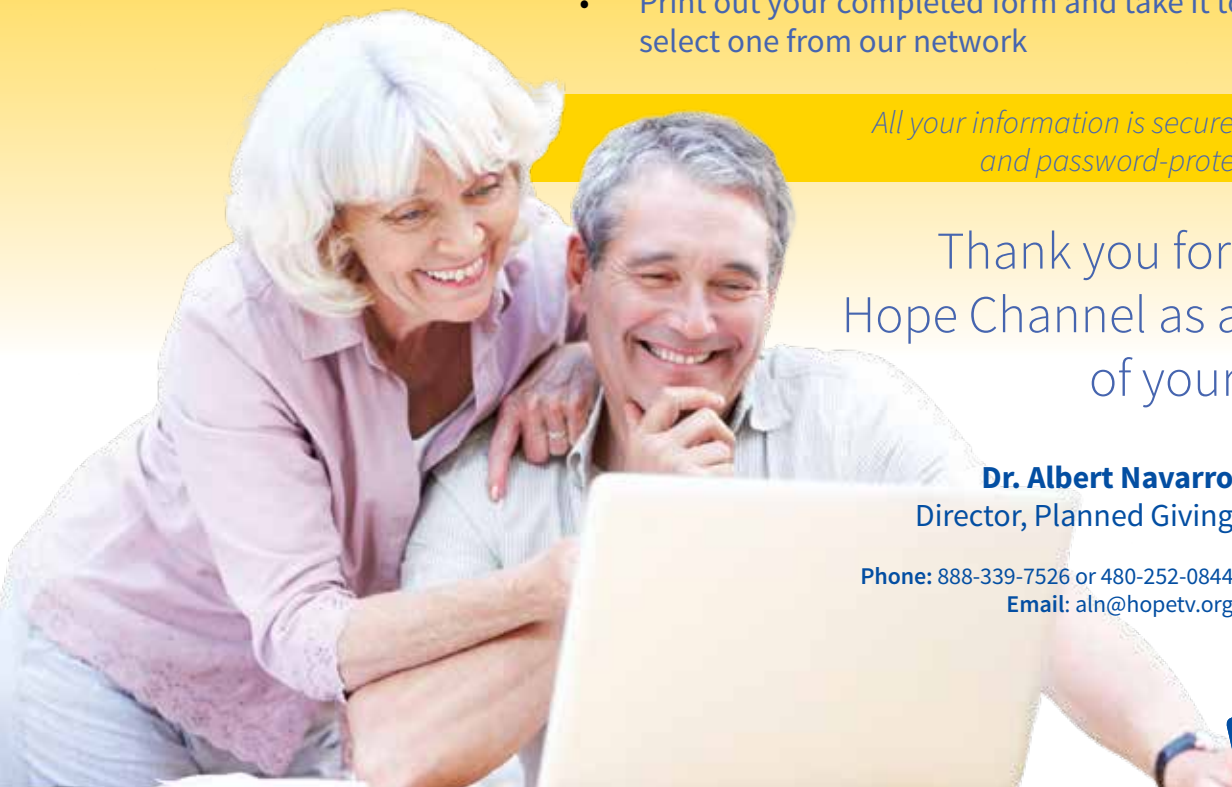
