- e) Which Scriptures emphasize the depths of God's immeasurable and unfailing love for His creation?

- a) Song of Solomon 5:16 Why is friendship an important foundation for any love relationship?
- b) How is friendship nurtured?
- c) John 15:13–15 What are your thoughts about being a friend of Jesus?

- a) How can friendship grow into love?
- b) Song of Solomon 4:9 How can you distinguish between genuine love and infatuation?
- c) Solomon expresses his love with both words and actions. Why is it important to express your thoughts and feeling to someone you love?

d) How can you discover a love language that the one you love can understand?

- a) Song of Solomon 4:16 What is the significance of the Shulamite calling "my garden" "his garden"?
- b) Why is it important to remember intimacy is a gift rather than an entitlement?
- c) 1 Corinthians 7:3–5 How does Paul's teaching about Christian marriage help us to understand the gift of intimacy?
- d) How can we nurture appropriate intimacy in human relationships?
- e) How can we nurture an intimate relationship with God?

#### 5. The right time

- a) Song of Solomon 4:12 Why is it important to wait until marriage to express sexual intimacy?
- b) Genesis 2:24–25
- c) 1 Corinthians 6:15–18
- d) Share your testimony about the importance of waiting until the right time.
- e) What counsel would you give to a friend who regrets inappropriate expressions of intimacy?
