

Right now, there are only two in our group, but God has led several others to attend in the past. I do not have teaching skills and I am timid to speak publicly, but I use Hope Sabbath School materials to learn and equip myself to lead out in my Bible study.


Bible HelpDesk

The Verse



The Crow's Nest



HOPE CHANNEL APP

If you were to ask yourself how many apps you have downloaded onto your smartphone, how many would you estimate you have? Research has revealed that the average person has nearly 90 apps downloaded on their smartphone and uses approximately 30 of them every month. With the two leading app marketplace competitors offering a collective 3.9 million apps for download, one could quickly recognize the need for a cuttingedge Hope Channel app to be amongst the ranks and easily accessible to every nation, kindred, tongue, and people.

This is where the crossroads of being mission-minded and utilizing the power of technology meet to seize the opportunity to exponentially expand Hope Channel's reach with Bible-based programs. Navigating this journey was Justin Woods, Hope Channel International's Manager of Web Services. In this role, Justin oversees Hope Channel's online presence, including the website, apps, and online video.

Although Hope Channel had a small but significant variety of apps available in the past, Justin noticed room for improvement in the user experience and saw an opportunity to make a new app available on a variety of platforms. This idea would go beyond providing a solution for North America and would extend to the growing global network of Hope Chan-

nel affiliates. He knew the idea would be a substantial undertaking that would require careful thought and planning from the visual design to the geolocation capability.

"The apps we use every day have become so engrained in our lives that it can be easy to forget how much time, effort, and resources go into making them. Creating custom apps for multiple platforms is complex and expensive, so naturally a non-profit ministry like us needed to take a careful, considered approach before jumping in. Once we decided to do it, however, it was full steam ahead," Justin shared.

Like any big idea worth pursuing, the journey took time and started with casting a vision of what could be accomplished with launching a brand new app. As others caught the vision, initial talks began with a few well-respected companies known in the app development world. After narrowing down the list, Hope Channel made the decision to move forward with Brightcove as the app development partner. Brightcove is an industry leader in the world of online video known for their technical innovation. They have worked with customers ranging from BBC Worldwide, PBS, Foxtel, Sony and now include Hope Channel on their list.

From project approval to a finished product, this undertaking took approximately one year to complete. "The logistics of creating a custom app across half a dozen different device platforms that is able to support more than 50 global channels and almost 20 languages boggles the mind," shared Justin. "I am grateful for the support of Hope Channel's leadership team, without it this project never could have happened."

To date, the Hope Channel app has been downloaded more than 300,000 times and the rate of new installs has more than tripled since the previous version. When it comes to mobile activity of weekly app users, the numbers have more than doubled and are expected to continue increasing with an ongoing promotional campaign.

based on your language and where you are in the world. Or how the screens for each program have the same look and feel on the Hope Channel app as well as the Hope Channel website," expressed Justin.

Another significant feature of the Hope Channel app is the option of off-line playback, offering users the ability to download episodes of programs directly to their device. This feature gives those around the world who experience limited or intermittent Internet access the opportunity to download Hope Channel content when they have an Internet connection and view it at a later time when they are out of Internet range.

"I had a couple of big dreams for the new Hope Channel app. One of those dreams

If you were to ask Justin what one of his favorite features of the Hope Channel app is, his answer would reveal his appreciation for the small details that add up.

"It's the little things! Things that most people might never notice. For example, how the app automatically selects the most appropriate Hope Channel for you was that all of our global Hope Channel affiliates would be able to put their content on it, expanding the reach of their ministry. Another dream was that the user experience would be the best of any religious video app. And the third dream was that we could support all the major platforms that apps can live on with the same beautiful and consistent experience." shared Justin.

The new app is available on all the major platforms including the Apple Store, Google Play, Roku, Apple TV, and Amazon Fire.

When asked what he would like the Hope Channel audience to know about the app, Justin shared, "Ultimately, we want to help Hope Channel viewers around the world connect more deeply with God's Word, and the transforming power that comes with truly knowing Jesus.

One of the most important things our audience can do to support the global mission of this app is to install it on all of their devices and leave us a rating on an app platform, such as the Apple Store or Google Play."

In May of this year, we formally changed our corporate name from "Hope Channel, Inc." to "Hope Channel International, Inc." The name change that now includes "international" was a decision voted and approved during the 2018 General Conference Annual Council The purpose for the change is to capture and communicate the global evangelistic ministry and network coordination role performed by the Hope Channel entity based out of Silver Spring, Marvland.

"Our name change to Hope Channel International, Inc. represents the global scope of our ministry and unique function as the coordinating office for the Hope Channel affiliates around the world. As of today, the Hope Channel network has 54 affiliates broadcasting in 60 languages, and by God's blessing, we continue to grow," shared Hope Channel International President, Derek Morris. "While our name is changing, the organizational structure of the Hope Channel network is not "

As part of the network coordinating role performed by Hope Channel International, Inc., the US-based office is responsible for various functions, including but not limited to: licensing affiliate channels that join the Hope Channel network, maintaining logo and branding consistency throughout the network, hosting annual leadership conferences to address network matters, and providing technical support resources for studio development.

In addition to being the coordinating entity of the global television network of the Seventhday Adventist Church, Hope Channel International, Inc. (HCI) is also responsible for the operation of the North American channels, including the production and acquisition of programs for Hope Channel's North American audience.

"The change to our corporate name now reflects Hope Channel in North America's distinctive role when it comes to our operational relationship with our affiliate channels. Although HCI operates in North America and produces and broadcasts programming for our North American audience, we also serve as a coordinating office for the international network of affiliate channels we are part of," shared Hope Channel International's Director of Marketing, Christina Zaiback-Khabbaz. "Our corporate name change will not impact our viewers or sustaining partners. As a matter of fact, our logo will not be changing, however, we still believe it's important they are aware of the change to our corporate name."

HOLY LANDS STUDY TOUR

An incredibly loud siren filled the air as the members of the 2019 Hope Channel Holy Lands Study Tour were eating dinner one Tuesday night at their hotel in Tel Aviv. No one seemed worried or fearful of the strident sound that invaded their ears and shook their bones.

It was not a siren of warning, but of remembrance.

This signal was a reminder of the victims of the Holocaust; the 6 million lives lost to hatred. The group stood, as instructed, in silence for the two minutes the siren sounded. By the end, several individuals had tears in their eyes.

The silence lasted a few moments longer once the siren faded away. No one dared even breathe too loudly. Finally, someone spoke.

"Welcome to Israel."



Hope Channel's second annual study tour took place on May 7-16, 2019 in the Holy Lands. The 43 guests quickly learned that the siren they heard on their first night was not the only signal of remembrance. All of Israel is a land of remembrance. Every site, every monument, and every street corner carries an air of significance and value.

From the lush breadbasket of the Galilee region to the ancient crowded streets of Jerusalem, everything cried out to be noticed and remembered. Most of all, the evidence of the greatest story ever told was apparent wherever one looked.

Our two guides, Oleg Kostyuk of Hope Channel's Cross Connection and local guide and pastor Sakher, led the group on a journey filled with historical significance and modern spiritual applications. Many attendees claimed this experience will forever change their reading and understanding not only of the Gospels, but of the entire Bible.

The days were packed with historical information, both of biblical importance and otherwise. But the most significant moments were those when the group had opportunity to reflect on the events that took place at the sites which they visited.

The group spent time praying and singing on the Mount of Beatitudes, overlooking



the Sea of Galilee. On Sabbath, worship was held while taking a morning ride across the water on a boat like Jesus and His disciples had often done. Whenever the group visited a domed church or chapel, requests would be made for songs of worship. Among the hubbub of Jerusalem, short moments were found to pause and reflect on the importance of the various sites that were visited. Yet perhaps the most significant moment was when the group visited the Garden Tomb.





Located in Jerusalem, and believed by many to be the site of Christ's crucifixion, burial, and resurrection, the group could feel a unique atmosphere at the Garden Tomb. One of reverence and peace. Derek Morris, president of Hope Channel International, led a moving communion service that touched the heart of every group member.

This service was our siren. When first instituting this ceremony, Christ told the disciples, "Do this in remembrance of me." Taking com-

munion was the reminder we needed of the purpose with which we had come to Israel. We had come to commune with history, gaining context and understanding of Scripture that would allow us to better share and teach about our living Savior, Jesus Christ.

"This tour has been life-changing," said one tour attendee. And many others would agree that walking where Jesus, David, Abraham, and so many other important biblical figures had trod has changed their lives forever.



An optional two-night excursion into Jordan to visit Petra, a historical and archaeological city marked as one of the seven new wonders of the ancient world, was offered at the end of Hope Channel's Holy Lands tour. Most who attended the tour opted for Petra and loved it! From the gorgeous caverns to the majestic man-made structures, the horse-drawn carriages to the camel rides, Petra was an experience that all our tour attendees will forever remember.





Ku-Band, C-Band, megabits per second, satellite communications, these terms are frequently used amongst the staff at Hope Channel International, located in Silver Spring, MD, who are responsible for broadcasting and distributing Hope Channel's programs in the North American region. Interesting facts, but what does all of this mean? In May of this year the decision was made to transition from using Ku-Band frequency to C-Band. On the surface the significance of this decision may not be clear, so we sat down with the Director of International Development at Hope Channel International, Joe Sloan, and asked him several questions about this change and what it means for Hope Channel and its audience in the United States.

Q: For the average reader, what is C-Band?

A: C-Band is a range of satellite frequen-

cies that is favored by the commercial television industry for satellite delivery of cable and broadcast programming to TV. One of the several benefits of using C-Band is that it performs better under adverse weather conditions, such as rain. This is one reason why it's preferred over the previous Ku-Band services we had been using.

Q: Why is this big news?

A: As a result of this change, Hope Channel will be able to significantly extend its reach into the American TV industry by taking our main feed to the largest cable entities. This decision has positioned us to be even more appealing to cable entities looking to acquire Christian programming as part of what they offer their viewers.

Q: Will this help the mission of Hope Channel?

A: Absolutely. Here at Hope Channel we



believe that our Bible-based programs should be made available to as many people as possible. By switching to C-Band, our transmission signal will be made available to many homes in the United States that have not previously been able to see it. This is a significant milestone for Hope Channel both today and into the future.

Q: Will this development change anything for our viewers?

A: For those already watching Hope Channel on DirecTV, or any of the broadcast and cable systems who carry us, it will not change anything. For those who have cable or satellite TV that do not have Hope Channel available to them, Hope Channel may become available on their system at a future date. Because we are now on C-Band, we have positioned ourselves to be more appealing for cable networks to pick-up Hope Channel.

We asked Hope Channel International's President, Derek Morris, what he thought of the recent development.

"I'm excited to have our Hope Channel signal available on C-Band. We are praying for tens of thousands of families in North America who will have the potential to watch relevant Christ-centered, Biblebased programming, sharing God's good news of a better life for today and for eternity."

As a result of switching to C-Band, Fidelity Communications will begin to carry Hope Channel on their lineup starting September 2019! Fidelity provides coverage within Missouri, Oklahoma, Arkansas, Texas and Louisiana.
