Over the past few months at Hope Channel, we added two new television programs to our program line-up, The Verse and Bible HelpDesk. To give our readers behind-the-scenes insight into the show, we "sat down" with the producers of each program - here is what they had to say.

The Verse Produced by Elroy Byam

What is The Verse?

The Verse is an attempt to provide a space for a demographic that hasn't often been tapped into. Many young adults express that they have not felt seen or heard. As a Bible-based network, I asked myself the question - how can we connect the needs of young adults with our messaging? I think one of the greatest ways to do that is in a university atmosphere - so why not go to a university to provide a platform for young adults and hear their thoughts of the Bible? I've grown to believe that intimacy is grown through the swapping of stories. What better way to start developing connections with younger viewers than hearing their stories?

That was the beauty of our casting call. We listened. It was amazing to hear the stories that trickled out of these students. Each story was unique and each story was beautiful in and of itself. Had we not given them the chance, we would have walked past them and never knew what they had to say.

Did you have a target demographic in mind when producing this show?

I did. I wanted to look at the 18-35 demographic because I feel like they are the least targeted within our church. They are a shrinking class within our Church, and I think that may be

because they are often the least listened to. We wanted to hear them, which is why I wanted to focus on this specific demographic.

The question is often asked in the church, "where are the young people?" I would say, they are still here. They still pray, they are still reading their Bible, however, they may not be doing those things in the traditional spaces—but they are still connected. This is what led me to ask the question, how do we continue to develop conversations with a younger audience? For starters, I would say simply meet them where they are. Jesus went to where the broken were. He didn't expect people to come to where He was, He met them where they were.

What inspired the series?

I have a love for all people, and when I feel that there is a group of people who aren't being heard, my heart feels that because I've grown-up not feeling heard. When you feel like you don't have a voice, sometimes you retreat and don't speak. And many people can walk by you and not realize that you have something to say. So, my thesis has always been - where do we find people who have something to say but aren't often heard? And how do we develop connections with them? We do a lot of talking, but we don't do a lot of listening. The Verse is supposed to be a listening experience as much as it's supposed to be a talking experience. We want to hear a person's experience and also hear their Biblical perspective.



What kind of topics does The Verse cover?

The Verse covers a lot of topics that I think a lot of people deal with openly and privately – love, fear, death, forgiveness, restoration. This is what we aimed to cover in the first season of The Verse. All of those topics were based on things people normally build conversations around. When you are having a conversation with someone, it will usually come down to one of those themes. How to love? What is my purpose? What am I most afraid of? How do we deal with grief and death in our lives from loved ones? How do we deal with relationships – friendships or romantic relationships? What is restoration and how do I experience it? How do we allow God to restore us? How do we allow God to use us to restore others?

What was the biggest reward of producing The Verse?

Being able to go back to my Alma Mater (Andrews University) to tape the series of The Verse. Being able to listen to young people and have conversations with young adults to hear some of their struggles and some of the things they are dealing with. You hear a lot of unique stories being out in the field. Some of the speakers were excited just to have someone listen to them because some of these stories may not have been heard before. I would also say my greatest joy was being able to create space for a future viewer. Some of the messages of the young adults we interviewed blessed me. They came to me in a very timely way and I didn't even realize it.

What do you hope viewers take away from this program?

That there are everyday people that are going through similar experiences and letting our viewers know they are not alone in their experience

and can overcome. Even when they may feel like they are not overcoming, they can come back to the Word and experience the Word in a different way. The Verse is supposed to be an arrow just pointing people back to the Bible in its simplest form. It's telling people, go back and look at some of those verses that you've read from when you were young. Go back and listen to the Bible and discover what can be drawn from it today. People are looking for answers and sometimes those answers are in the form of Bible verses, even very simple ones.

As the producer of the program, what is one thing you would want viewers to know about The Verse?

The Verse is a response to those that are crying out but haven't heard an answer. And that response is, we see you. We hear you. And we want you to know, God loves you. That is in its most rudimentary form. It's the deep calling within each of us, we want to be loved, and we want to be reminded of it every day.

Bible HelpDesk Produced by Hannah Luttrell

What is Bible HelpDesk?

Bible HelpDesk is a live question-and-answer program, where viewers send in their questions via phone call, email, text, or social media, and a panel of Bible experts answer them using the Bible.

What inspired the series?

I understand the concept for this program preceded my arrival at Hope Channel and had been a dream of president Derek Morris for years.



What is the role of the Bible HelpDesk hosts versus the Bible experts?

Our hosts open up each week's program and read the questions from our viewers. Our panel of Bible experts vary from week to week, so the hosts provide a familiar face for our viewers and also help guide our experts on-air in their television experience.

How is the panel of Bible experts chosen?

We look for men and women who not only view the Bible as authoritative and inspired but who also demonstrate a firm, deep and broad grasp of the Bible.

What questions does Bible HelpDesk cover?

Any question that can be answered from the Bible! That includes both questions about Bible verses and concepts in the Bible, but also questions from everyday life that can be answered using the principles and practical wisdom found in the Bible.

How are the questions chosen?

We prioritize questions that will be applicable and relevant to a significant portion of our viewers, questions on serious topics with eternal or salvific impact, and questions on topics that have not been addressed before or recently.

Does the panel know the questions in advance?

Not if the question comes in during the live program or shortly before, but we are usually able to share with them some of the questions which have come in during the week or previous weeks.

What is the biggest challenge of doing a live broadcast?

Deciding which questions to answer within the 28-minute time frame!

What has surprised you the most about the new program?

At first I wasn't sure if we would receive any questions, but the very first week we received over 70! It's kind of fun to see the questions that come in too—ones that make you think. You realize how much people out there are really searching for truth, for answers, and I'm so thankful that we can help provide this resource for them.

What do you hope viewers take away from this program?

We want to focus not just on information, but on transformation. People are saved by a relationship with God, not just by having accurate knowledge. More than just giving right answers, we want to connect people with the right God—a God who loves them more than life itself. In every answer, I encourage my hosts and experts to look for every opportunity to point to Christ and the love of God.


