HEY KIDS!

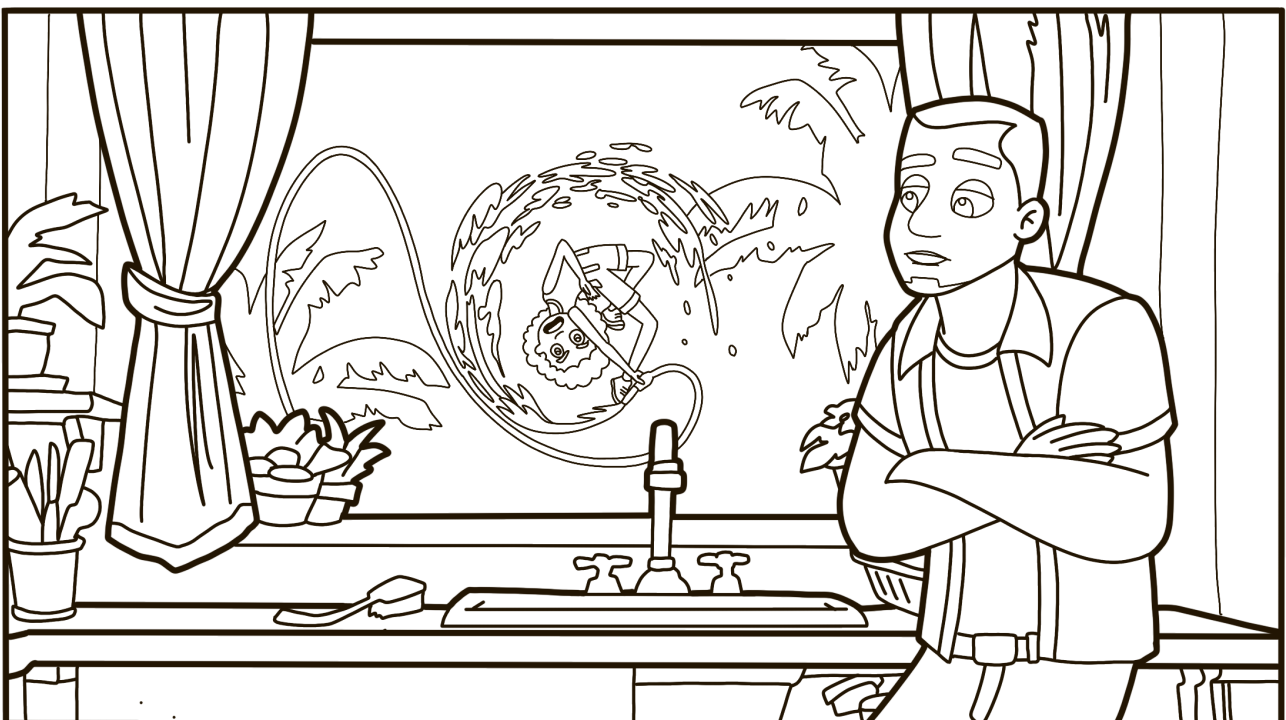
Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, the Tuis find out that Nanda has to stay in hospital for another two days, so decide to extend their trip. Seeing the state of the backyard, Salome decides she wants to surprise Nanda with a renovation! While the family offers to help, Salome is determined to do it alone. After a few mishaps with the hose and lawnmower, she realises she can't do it herself so everyone pitches in. In the end, Nanda is amazed at her new backyard!

Bible lesson

- Sometimes in life we forget our limitations and think we can do things by ourselves. In the Bible, the Holy Spirit is called our “helper” (John 14:26). Just like Sefa whispered to Salome in the bush, the Holy spirit “whispers” or impresses messages on our hearts. He instructs us in how to reach others who don't know Jesus.

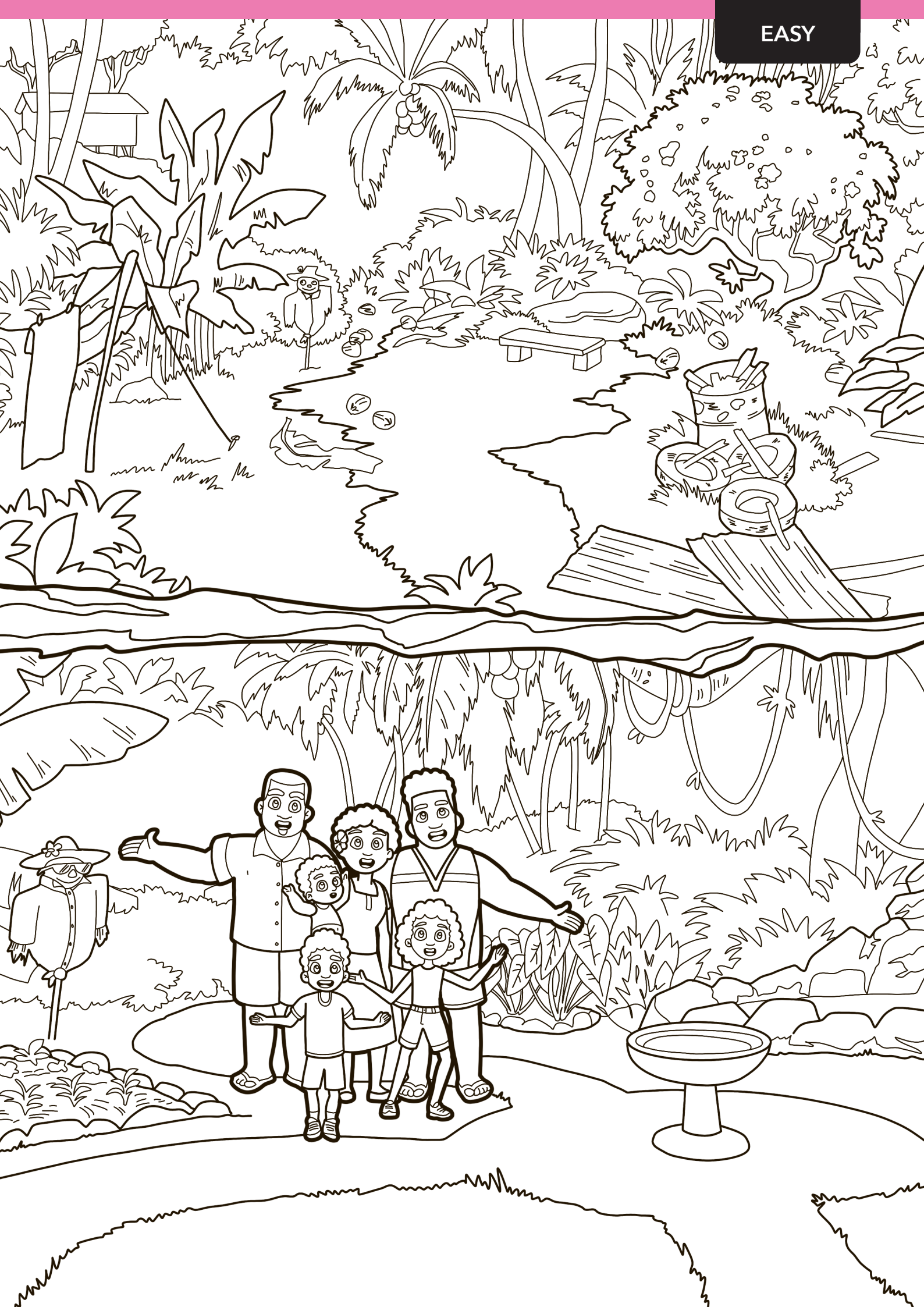

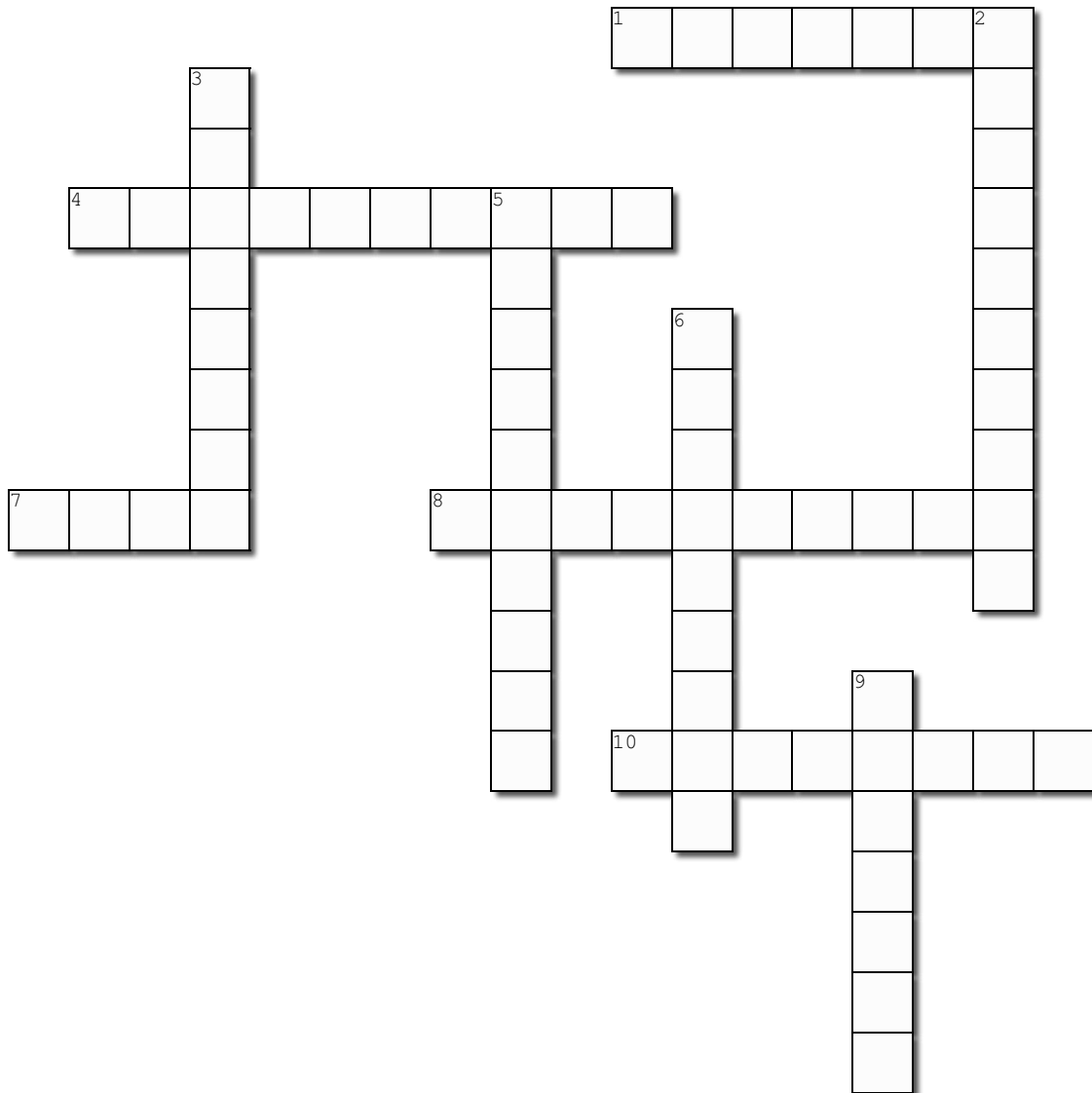
DID YOU KNOW?

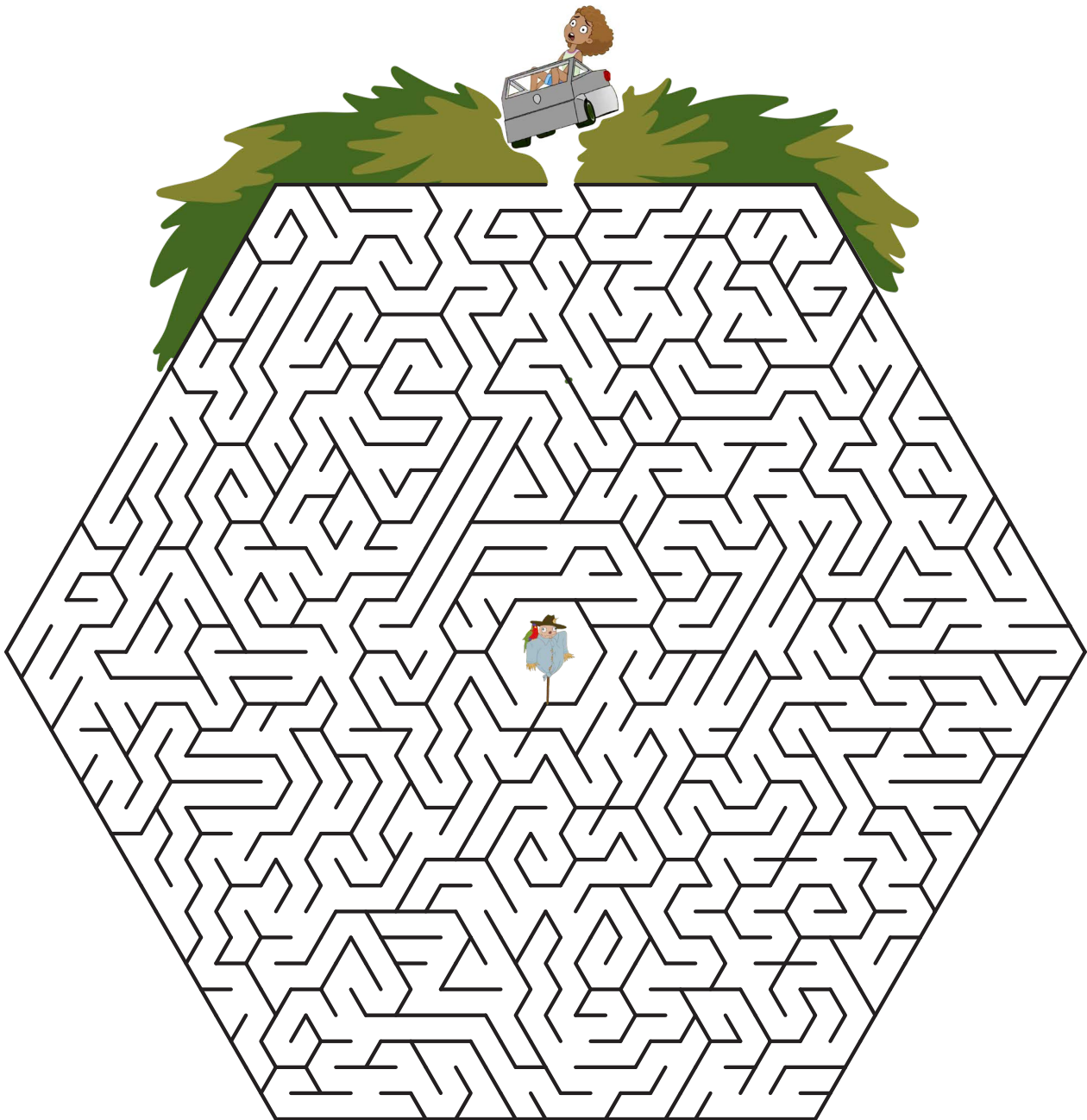

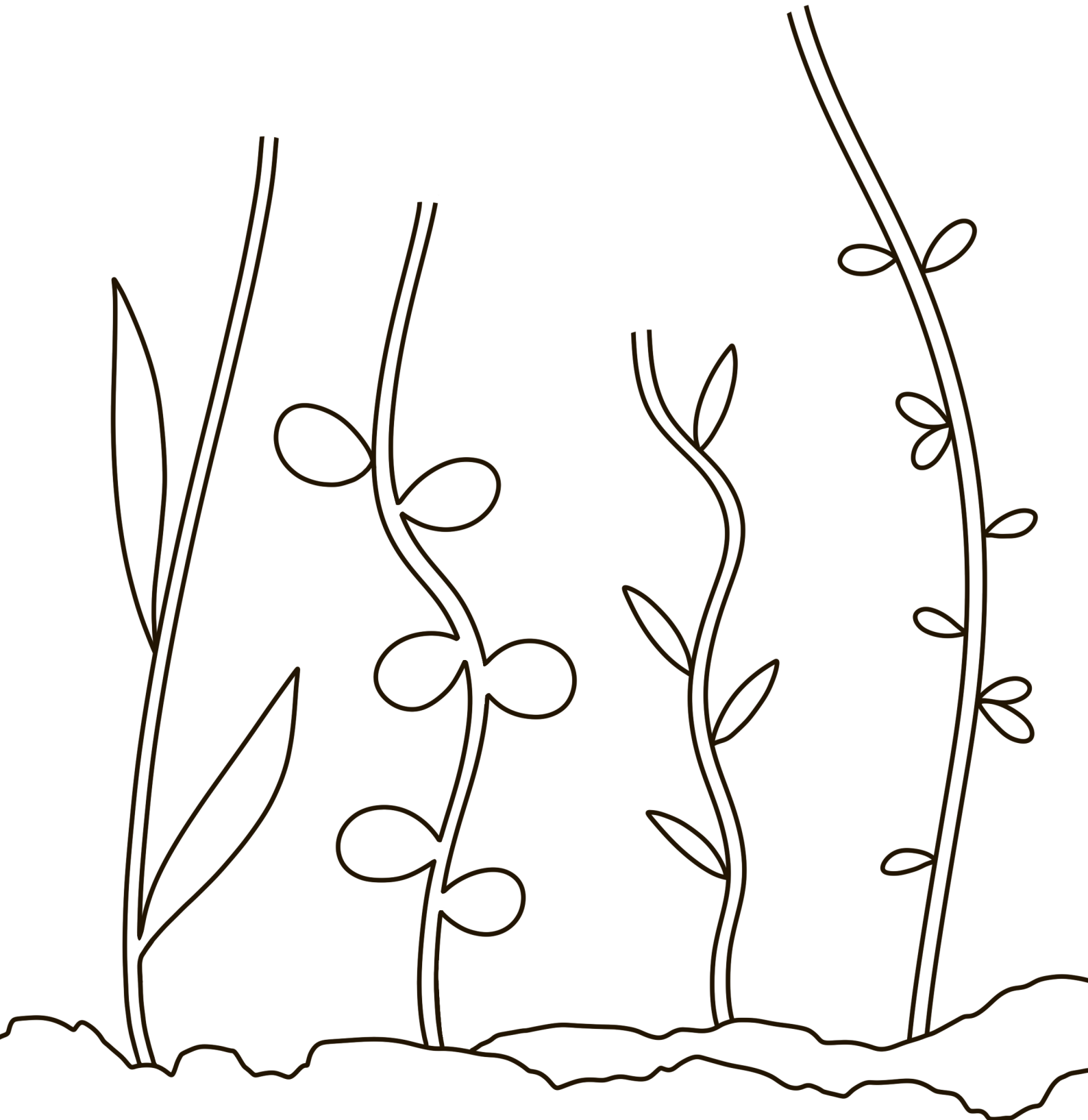

Can you make Nanda's garden grow? **Draw some unique flower designs!**

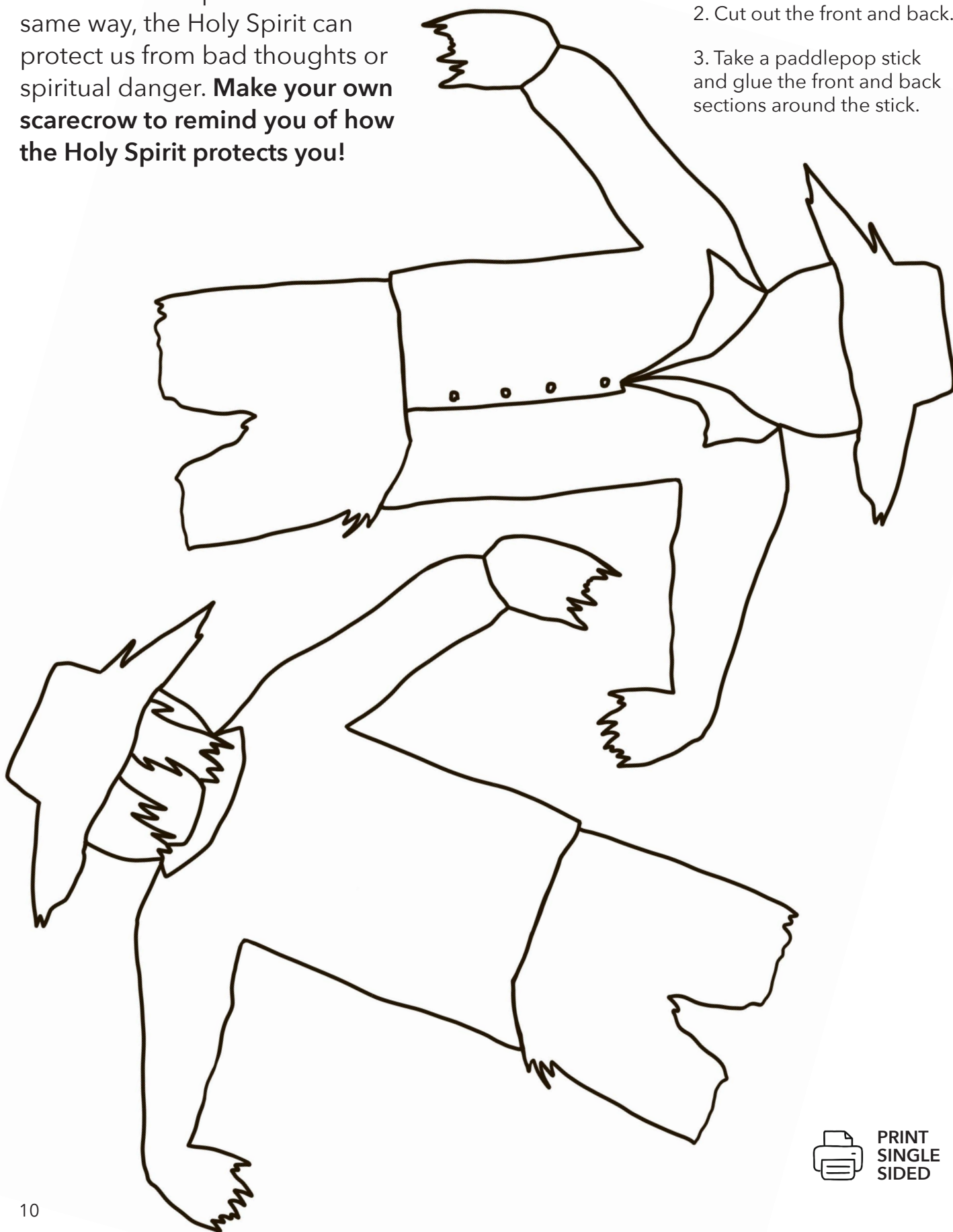


CRAFT ACTIVITY

FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

Renovation Challenge

Why not spruce up a room in your home and create space for a prayer or reading nook?
