HEY KIDS!

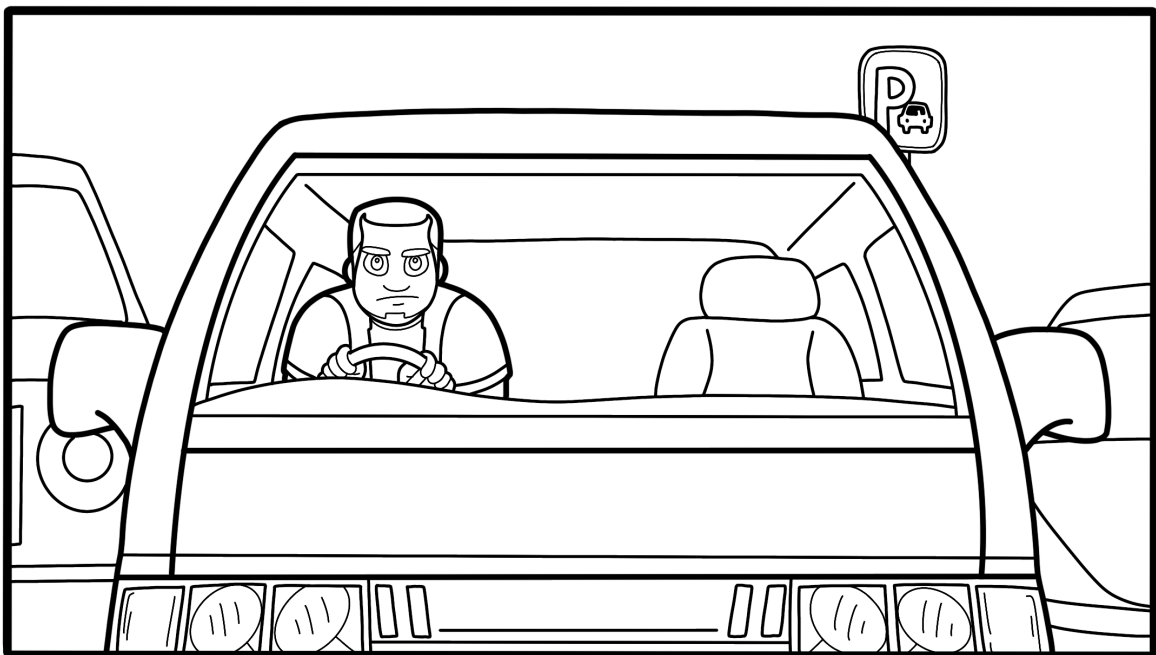
Before you start this booklet, ask your parent or guardian to read to you the episode questions on page 11 and go through the Discovery Bible Reading activity. This will give you the information and clues you need to finish the puzzles and activities.

Episode summary

- In this episode, Jono is desperate to meet his hero—John Brown, the creator of Wombat Man—at his local shopping mall. Due to arrive at 1pm, a huge crowd turns up to meet him. But as the hours pass and John still hasn't arrived, people lose hope. Eventually, it's only Jono, Costa and their friend waiting in the line. When John finally arrives, Jono makes it his mission to tell everyone in the shopping centre... and eventually a long line forms again. Jono feels proud of himself and gets John to sign his new Wombat Man t-shirt!

Bible lesson

- Just like everyone gets tired of waiting in line, the Bible says that many people will get tired of waiting for Jesus to return, too. The few that wait are called the "remnant", and—just like Jono—are called to proclaim to the world that Jesus is coming soon. Every believer is invited to be a part of this remnant, and to proclaim the Three Angels' Messages found in Revelation 14.

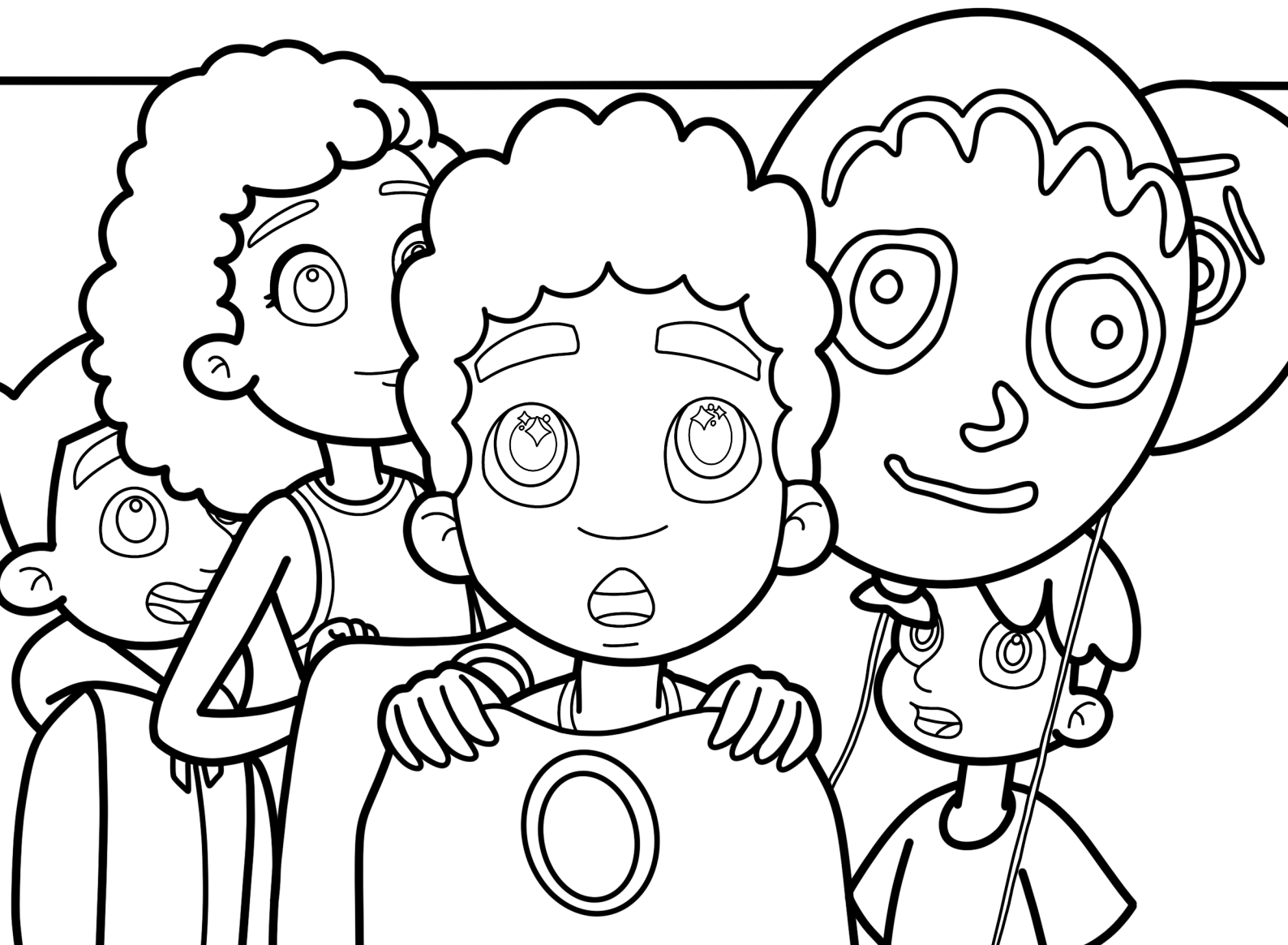

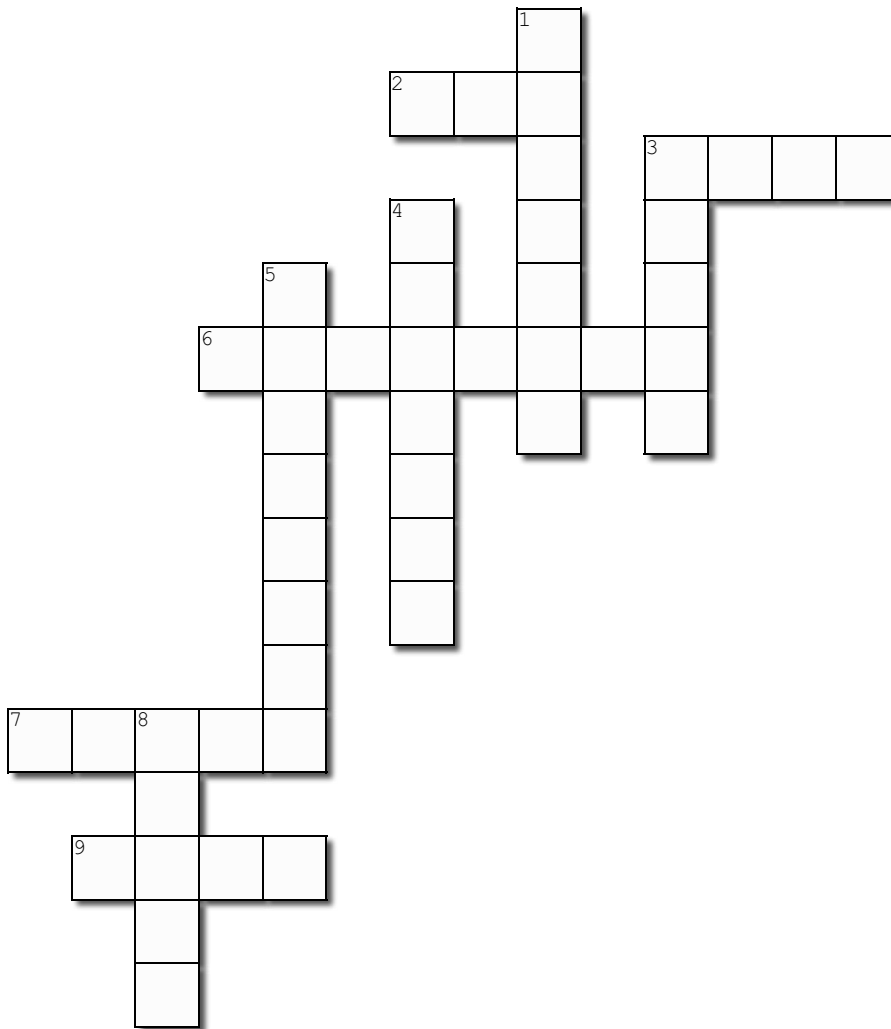
DID YOU KNOW?

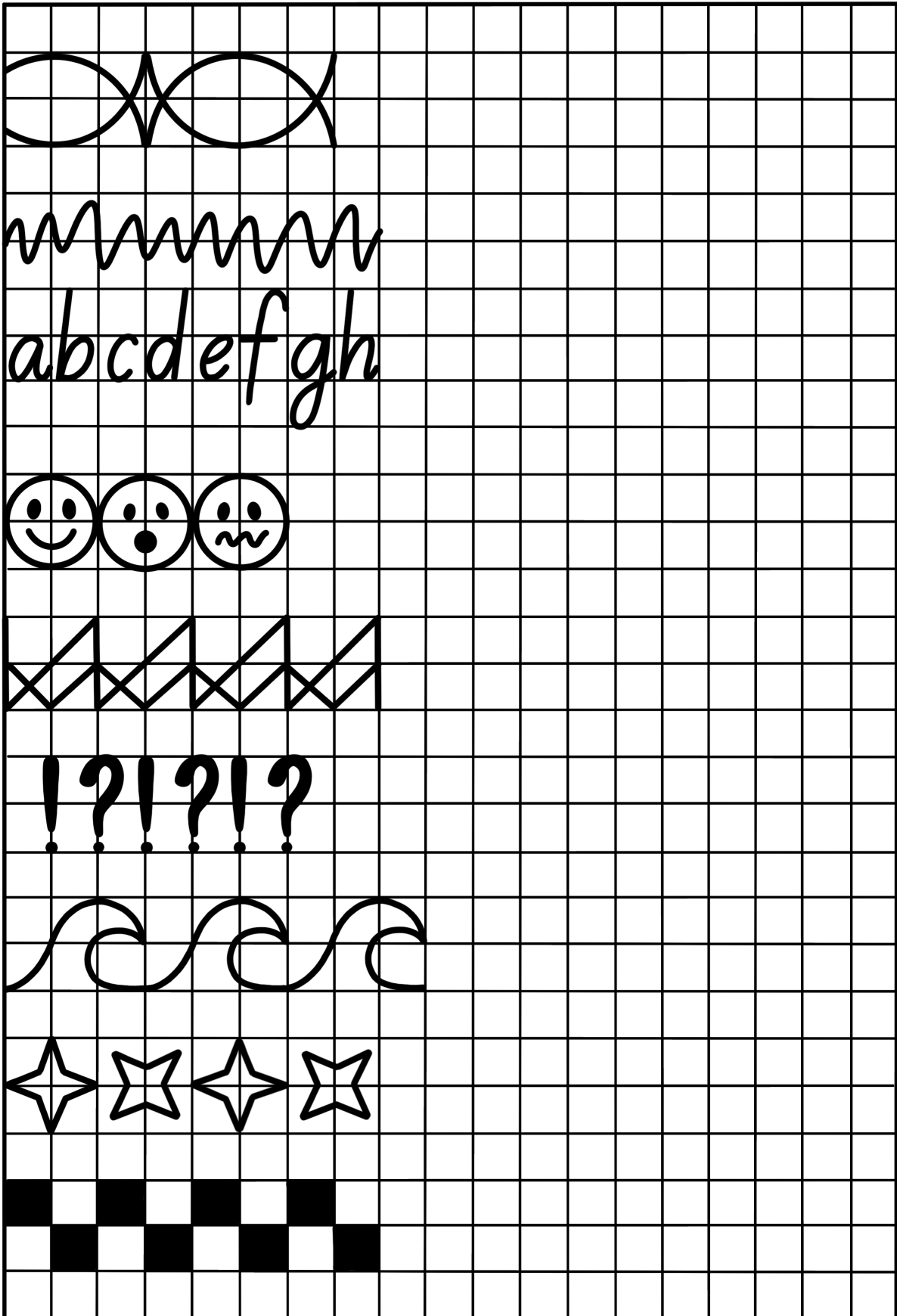
SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

Can you find and circle them all?



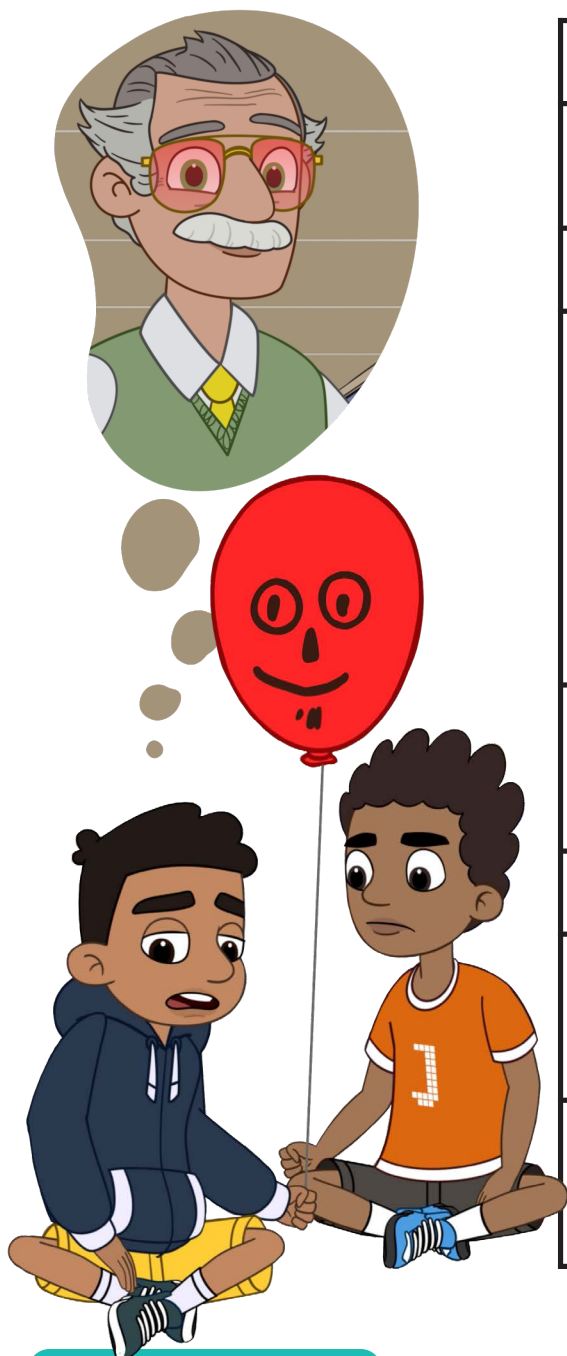
KEEP IT GOING

Can you keep each design in line? Continue each pattern to the other side of the graph to make sure everyone doesn't miss seeing John Brown!

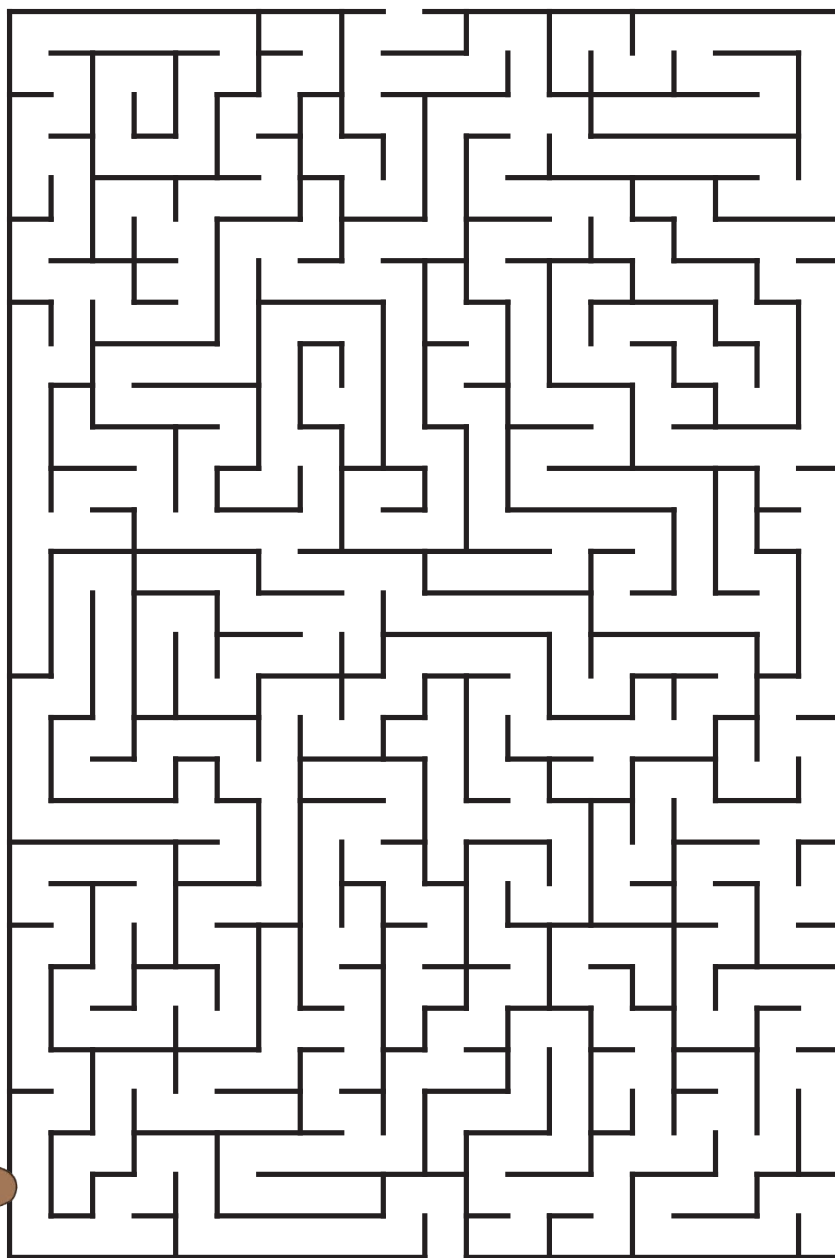

FAMILY WORSHIP IDEA

Pass the parcel

If you want to teach your kids patience, try this classic party game.

What you'll need:

- Newspaper and sticky tape
- Small prize (e.g. lolly) and a big prize
- Strips of paper with Bible verses
- A dice (optional)

Step 1: Wrap the big prize in layers of newspaper (2-3 layers per player). Put a small prize and a Bible verse in each layer.

Step 2: Have player 1 roll the dice and pass the parcel that many times to the left. Alternatively, have a parent or guardian yell "stop" randomly.

Step 3: Each time the parcel stops, that player opens one layer, retrieves their prize and reads the verse. Play until you reach the big prize!
